Spokane County Fire District #13 is now accepting applications for the Resident Firefighter Program. The intent of this program is to provide experience, opportunity and training to qualified individuals interested in pursuing a career in the fire service.

Resident firefighters accepted into this program will be provided with living accommodations. In return, the firefighter will be required to fill the following each month:

- a. 8 weeknight shifts (9pm-6am)
- b. One 48-hour weekend shift (6am Saturday – 6am Monday)

BENEFITS

- Private sleeping quarter with common kitchen, bathroom, dayroom, laundry, and weight room
- Alarm response and firefighter duty assignment experience
- Continuing educational opportunities
- Uniform and required protective equipment needed to perform duties.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years of age.
- Must have a current Washington State EMT certification.
- Must have Firefighter 1 or equivalent training within the last 2 years.
- Possess a valid Washington State driver's license, an acceptable driving record, and at least 2 years of driving experience.
- Successfully pass a physical exam, including drug test and pulmonary test.
- Successfully pass a background investigation.
- Physically and mentally capable of performing the function of a Firefighter/EMT.
